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## Discussion (30 min)

1. Read John 13:1-5. What is meaningful or shocking to you in these verses and why?
2. What is an example of shocking service you have seen done recently? It's ok to share something that you did, especially if it was even shocking to you that you did it!
3. Read John 13:6-11. Discuss if it is easy or difficult for you to accept help from others? Why? Share a time you had to accept help. How did it impact you going forward?
4. Pastor PJ gave many examples of how Jesus helps us through His character. Healer, Friend, Peace, Author and Perfecter of Faith, Forgiver, Provider, Bread of Life, Light, Refuge and Strength, feel free to list others. Which of these has He done for you lately?
5. Read John 13:12-17. How can you live a blessed life no matter what day it is or what is going on that day?
6. **Application questions:** What can I/we give? How can I/we serve?

## Closing Prayer

1. Invite your group to share personal prayer requests. Lift these up in prayer.
2. LORD, we thank You that You came down from Heaven to wash our feet! That you want us to be blessed! That You will love us to the end! Show us how we can wash the feet of others this week.
