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## Discussion (30 min)

1. Pastor PJ used the words consoling, encouraging, mediating on behalf of another and helper, counselor, advocate, and companion to describe the Holy Spirit. Which of these do you need the most today? Why is that attribute important?
2. Read John 16: 8, 13, 33. Give an example of when the Spirit has either convicted you, guided you, or given you peace. How did you know it was the Spirit?
3. Divide up these verses and share with your group any insights you have about these other “superpowers” of the Holy Spirit:
  - a. Romans 8:26-27
  - b. Ephesians 1:13-14
  - c. Romans 12:6-8, 1 Cor. 12:7-11
  - d. Acts 1:8
  - e. Galatians 5:22-23
4. How do we gain access to the Holy Spirit? (Acts 2:38-39) What have you done or are you doing to utilize the Gift? List practical examples you can do everyday.
5. **Application question:** How will you use the Spirit’s superpowers this week to push back the darkness and triumph over adversity?

## Closing Prayer

1. Invite your group to share personal prayer requests. Lift these up in prayer.
2. Holy Spirit, take control of our lives. Help us to not live by our own power, but by your supernatural powers within us. Convict us, guide us, and give us peace so we may lead others to You and serve You.
